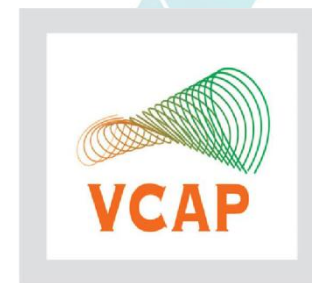

Identified Top 4 Priorities on Transport Sector for 2016-2017

- Implementing the 1st phase emission testing for in-used motorcycles with engine cylinder capacity from 175cm³ and above in 5 big cities
- Implementing the roadmap on adopting emission standards of Euro 3 for 2- wheel motorcycles and Euro 4 for new manufactured and imported automobiles; Tightening the emission standards for in-used automobiles
- Developing Green Freight: Action plan, Policies, Programs
- Implementing GHG inventories under the direction of the Decision No2359/QD-TTg dated 22nd December 2015 on National GHG inventories.

Identified Top 4 Priorities on AQM for 2016-2017

- Implementing Master Plan on Natural Resources and Environment Monitoring Network for 2016-2020 with a vision to 2030, focusing on expansion of the automatic air quality monitoring network nationwide
- Implementing National Action Plan on Air Quality Management until 2030, focusing on development of regulations on emission permitting; industrial emission inventory; using monitoring data for decision making
- Strengthening environmental compliance and enforcement
- Strengthening international cooperation related to air quality management

Ways of informing and engaging stakeholders in implementation of priority actions and programs

- Strengthening cooperation and coordination among relevant ministries and stakeholders: MONRE, MOT, MOIT, MOST, MOH, NGOs, academe, and Local authorities, e.g. provinces and cities
- Raising awareness for decision makers and public
- Increasing public participation in decision making process
- Mobilizing financial and technical supports from international organizations for AQM capacity building
- Effective usage of resources for better air quality
