Identified top 5 priorities for 2016-2017



1. Update the Integrated Air Quality Improvement Framework - Air Quality Control Action Plan which describes the National Air Quality Management System
2. Implement capacity building programs for and in partnership with airsheds (e.g. AQ management workshops for Governing Board)
3. Establish Motor Vehicle Inspection Stations / Centers nationwide to ensure compliance with emission standards to be spearheaded by the Department of Transportation through the Land Transportation Office
4. Collect data to support air quality communication (e.g. health impacts of air pollution, linkage between source emissions and ambient AQ)
5. Encourage local government units to include AQ management activities in their application for the 'Seal of Good Local Government' awarded by the Department of Interior and Local Government
